



The new discipleship classes for adults launch on Sunday, January 23. Begin the New Year by taking an important step in your discipleship growth. Join a class and walk with us as we experience Life Together!

- **Seniors and Friends** – Room 101 – This class taught by **Ken Snell** will explore 1 and 2 Thessalonians to discover what it means to live "Life Together" and follow Jesus in difficult times. This class welcomes seniors, older single adults or anyone who would like join us.
- **Latino Bible Class** – Ministerio Latino-Clase Bíblica. Salón 104 (también disponible a través de zoom). - **A Deeper Dive** – Main Auditorium (also via Live Stream) – This class will meet in the main auditorium to allow for social distancing, and will also be streamed live. - **Young Adults** - Room 102 – The North Atlanta Young Adult Ministry (NAYA) welcomes young adults (ages 22-35) of all backgrounds and life situations. We provide an encouraging space to serve, live, and grow together as we strive to Love First. **Brett Todd and Derek Nichols** will lead a study of the Letter of James, exploring life as God's people in a complex world.
- **Recovery Ministry – Women** - Recovery Ministry - Women - This discipleship offering is planned and led by **Jasmine Turner**, North Atlanta's Recovery Minister. This class is divided into small groups and discussions are taught by volunteer mentors. This study is for women who want to study the Bible through the lens of recovery principles in order to live transformed lives. Women in recovery as well as friends and advocates of recovery are welcome. It meets in Rooms 111 & 115.
- **Recovery Ministry – Men** – This discipleship offering is organized by **Jasmine Turner**, North Atlanta's Recovery Minister, and is taught each week by a group of male mentors. This class welcomes men who want to study the Bible through the lens of recovery principles in order to live transformed lives. Men in recovery as well as friends and advocates of recovery are welcome. This class meets in Room 105.
- **Catalyst Ministry** – The Catalyst ministry is led by a team that includes **Shauna Roberts, Brian Sharp, and DJay Wells**. The class meets in the Summit – second floor of the Student Center. It welcomes college-age adults from Atlanta and those attending colleges away from home on those weekends and holidays back in Atlanta.
- **Young Families** – Room 112 – This class will be taught by **Sarah Higinbotham** and will focus on three virtues that strengthen communities: hope, trust, and thankfulness. Lessons will be drawn on concepts from Dietrich Bonhoeffer's book - *Life Together*.
